School District Considers Closing Bay Farm Middle School

The Alameda Unified School District is studying the future of Bay Farm Middle School. One option AUSD officials discussed during the January 24 Board of Education meeting is a phased closure that would end new enrollment while allowing current students to continue attending.

According to information on the AUSD website the phased closure is in response to declining enrollment and other issues. A final decision is anticipated during the February 14 Board of Education meeting.

Alameda County Eviction Moratorium Update

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors has delayed, once again, discussing the ongoing rental housing moratorium or taking action on three new rental housing ordinances. These issues were scheduled for the Supervisors January 24 meeting. Early in the meeting, one of the Supervisors asked that all of the rental housing issues be moved to a future meeting. Simultaneously, tenant advocate protestors disrupted the meeting to the point that Board President Nate Miley called for the meeting to be adjourned. The rental housing issues could be on the agenda for the Supervisors February 7 meeting.
