Government affairs update for the week of December 31, 2023

Affordable Housing Community Meeting Jan 8

Alameda County Supervisors David Haubert and Elisa Márquez are hosting a hybrid inperson/virtual community meeting Monday, Jan 8, from 6:30 to 8pm at the Fremont Library to discuss a proposed \$10 to \$20 billion bond for affordable housing programs.

The bond, sponsored by the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG), would fund the construction of new affordable homes and preserve existing affordable housing. It would be paid for by revenue from property taxes. Approval of the bond may be on the Nov 5 General Election ballot.

The Bay East Association of REALTORS has not yet taken a position on this proposed bond.
