VA to Allow Veteran Buyers to Pay for Representation

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) will be allowing veteran homebuyers to pay for professional representation.

According to the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) VA loans are the only home purchase financing programs that prohibit borrowers from paying brokerage fees or commissions.

NAR has shared with VA officials that this policy could leave veteran buyers without representation in a real estate transaction or prevent them from using VA loans.

NAR said that REALTORS®, including Bay East leaders, who met with congressmembers in Washington DC earlier this month help convinced the VA to make this change.
