Local Politics Update - Mayors on the Move

There's a new mayor in Dublin and there will be several mayoral races on the ballot this November.

This week, Dublin Mayor Melissa Hernandez resigned to accept an appointment to serve on the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) Board of Directors representing District 5. Hernandez is filling the position held by John McPartland, who resigned in April. District 5 includes Dublin, Pleasanton, Livermore and parts of Hayward.

During its June 4 meeting, the Dublin City Council appointed Council Member Michael McCorriston as mayor. McCorriston will serve as mayor through December 2024. Council members Sherry Hu and Jean Josey have already announced they intend to run for mayor.

Mayoral candidates also will be on the ballots in Fremont, Livermore, Pleasanton and Union City later this year.

The Bay East Political Activities Committee has already been meeting with candidates for these and other local races, and the Bay East Board of Directors will be sharing its list of endorsed candidates prior to the November 5 general election.
