Rent Control Town Hall September 9

On Nov. 5, California voters will determine the future of rent control.

Proposition 33 will overturn the Costa-Hawkins Act, the 1995 law that restricts cities and counties from imposing rent control on some residential properties including single-family homes and condominiums.

The California Association of REALTORS® is hosting a virtual town hall on Monday, Sept. 9, from 11 a.m. to noon to discuss the potential impacts of Proposition 33.

Last Chance to Help Save Independent Contractor Status for REALTORS®

The NAR <u>Call for Action</u> asking members of Congress to co-sponsor H.R. 5419 is ending soon. The Direct Seller and Real Estate Agent Harmonization Act will ensure real estate agents maintain their independent contractor status under the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA).
