## Financial Relief for Housing Providers in Unincorporated Alameda County

The Alameda County Housing and Community Development (HCD) Department Housing Provider Small Grant Recovery Program is providing grants up to \$10,000 for housing providers operating in the unincorporated areas of Alameda County. This includes Castro Valley, San Lorenzo, Ashland and Cherryland.

According to the HCD, the program's goal is to address the loss of revenue to rental housing providers in the unincorporated county during the COVID-19 pandemic. Payments will be made directly to rental housing businesses or sole proprietors who demonstrate ownership of the property.

Grant applications are due by 5 p.m. on Friday, Nov 1, 2024. Grants will be awarded using a lottery system.
