Paragon MLS End-User License Agreement

On December 13, when you or your agents log in to Paragon, you will be directed to accept the End-User License Agreement (EULA). We are required to register the MLS Database annually with the U.S. Copyright Office to maintain all copyright protections for the property listings compilation.
