





SHORTAGE FINDINGS OF AUDITS CLOSED 1/1/19 - 12/31/19

- Total audits closed 483
- > \$7.7 Million
- > 32.5% had shortages
- 60 audits > \$10,000 short,12.4%

COMMON AUDIT FINDINGS

- > Trust fund shortages on PM and BE audits
- Lack of broker oversight
- Broker-controlled escrow activities and failure to report to DRE
- Delays in providing records
