## **New Tenant Noticing Requirements**

Effective September 1, weekends and court holidays cannot be included when determining the time periods for noticing a tenant to pay rent, perform covenant or file an answer for an unlawful detainer and other actions.

The new rules do not change how the 30 and 60-day termination notice periods are calculated. More information <a href="here">here</a>. (login required)

## **Let's Get Serious About Housing**

The root of the current housing affordability crisis is lack of supply and new residential construction.
