Tougher Sign Rules Coming to Fremont

On Tuesday, November 5 the Fremont City Council moved forward on tougher open house sign rules.

The Council accepted City of Fremont staff recommendations to limit the total number of signs that may be displayed at an intersection, ban the placement of signs near historic buildings and require signs placed on sidewalks leave more space for pedestrians.

A final version of the new sign rules are expected to be approved in early 2020.
