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#### **Pleasanton Offers Emergency Rent Assistance**

This week, the Pleasanton City Council approved an Emergency Rental Assistance Program to help tenants impacted by the COVID-19 pay their rent. The program provides grants to residents earning no more than 80% of the area median income (adjusted for household size) and who have had a lease to rent a unit in Pleasanton for at least the last six months.
