NAR Takes Eviction Moratorium Concerns to the White House

Federal policy makers need to help "Mom and Pop" housing providers.

That was the message delivered to the White House by National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) President Vince Malta.

According to NAR, last week Malta (who is a San Francisco-based REALTOR®) and other NAR leaders met with the Domestic Policy Council and the National Economic Council to express concerns about the impact of the recent Centers for Disease Control (CDC) eviction moratorium.

Malta said the moratorium is hurting housing providers and adding another layer of complicated regulations on top of state, regional and local rental housing rules.

The NAR team asked for direct relief for rental housing providers who cannot receive unemployment, Paycheck Protection Program or other loans.
