San Leandro Flood Zone Resources

Detailed information about flood zones and flood insurance is available from the City of San Leandro.

The Division of Building and Safety Services can provide a preliminary determination if a property is in the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Special Flood Hazard Area and other flood-related information. City staff ask anyone using these resources to provide the property street address, nearest cross street, assessor's parcel number, full name, affiliation and telephone number, and, if available, the subdivision, lot and block number.
