Alameda County Still Pushing More Rental Housing Rules

Last month, Alameda County staff made a presentation at the Castro Valley Municipal Advisory Committee (MAC) meeting about new rental housing rules including:

- Just Cause evictions for **all** rental properties,
- Rental Unit Registry and Eviction Notification Ordinance,
- Fair Chance Ordinance that would eliminate criminal background checks,
- Proactive Rental Inspection Program,
- Rent Review Board, and
- “Rent Stabilization” (i.e. Rent Control) Ordinance

On Tuesday, December 7, at 6pm County staff will be presenting these new rules to the Fairview Municipal Advisory Committee. This presentation is the next step towards having the County Supervisors approve the rules. As with the Castro Valley MAC meeting, this is an opportunity to stop this proposal before it gets to the Supervisors.

Pleasanton May Ban Smoking in Condo and Townhome “Public” Spaces

On Tuesday, December 7, the Pleasanton City Council may take the first step to ban smoking in the common areas of owner-occupied multifamily housing developments including condominiums and townhomes.

If approved, the [ordinance](#) will outlaw smoking on balconies, decks, and patios and in hallways, lobbies, and community rooms. The Council may also consider an option to ban smoking inside of privately-owned units, as well.
