### Flood Insurance Program at Risk - Again

While much of California is heading for another year of drought conditions, securing flood insurance is still an issue for many homebuyers.

This week, the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) announced that the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) is at risk of losing its funding on March 11.

NAR is actively working with Congress to secure a long-term source of funding for the NFIP.
