Bay East Gears Up for 2022 Elections

While the June primary and November general elections are still months away, the Bay East Political Activities Committee is already hard at work. This week, the committee interviewed candidates for California Senate District 10, which includes communities from Hayward to Sunnyvale and candidates for California Assembly District 20, which covers parts of Fremont, Hayward and Castro Valley. More interviews are scheduled for next week. The committee will be making a recommendation to the California Association of REALTORS® that will make a final decision about which candidates they may support.

Closer to home, the committee also interviewed candidates for Alameda County District Attorney and Alameda County Sheriff. Candidates for both positions were asked about preventing property crimes and addressing real estate-related issues including serving evictions. They will make a recommendation to the Bay East Board of Directors that will make a final decision about which candidates they may endorse.

Bay East candidate endorsements will be published in member-only voter guides prior to the elections this year.

The Political Activities Committee consists of Bay East REALTOR® members who have years of experience in local and regional politics and volunteer hundreds of hours to interview candidates and build and maintain relationships with elected officials.
