Bill To Handcuff Landlords to their Rentals Stopped

State legislation to restrict the ability of property owners to sell rental housing units has been stopped.

According to the California Association of REALTORS® (C.A.R.), the State Assembly did not vote on AB 2050 this week.

C.A.R. indicated that responses to a recent Red Alert asking REALTORS® in the Tri-Valley to contact their State Assembly member was key to stopping the legislation.
