Masks Required in Alameda County - Again

Effective Friday, June 3, the Alameda County Public Health Department is requiring masks be worn in most public indoor settings. County officials confirmed this requirement applies to real estate open houses.

The requirement does not apply to the City of Berkeley, which is an independent Local Health Jurisdiction. The County has not indicated when the mask requirement will be lifted. More information is available here.
