Transfer Tax Opposition Advocacy Webinar

The [Community Tax Coalition](#) (CTC) is hosting a virtual National Real Estate Transfer Tax Policy Summit on June 24.

The webinar begins at 10 a.m. (Pacific Time) and will include policy experts, economists, grassroots leaders and advocates to discuss the use of real estate transfer taxes as a revenue source for governments.
