

Open House Sign Ordinances – Sacramento, CA

SIGN LOCATION

A temporary sign may not be located within or over the public right-of-way, except as follows: a temporary sign may be placed in that area of public right-of-way between the face of the street curb and the street side edge of the sidewalk (commonly referred to as the planting strip or the mowing strip). No person shall erect, construct or maintain any sign upon any property or building without the consent of the owner, person entitled to possession of the property or building if any, or their authorized representatives. A temporary sign may be staked in the ground; may be tacked, pasted, or otherwise temporarily affixed to legally existing fences, structures, and buildings; and may be taped, painted, or otherwise temporarily affixed to the interior or exterior surfaces of building windows

OF SIGNS ALLOWED

MAXIMUM SIGN HEIGHT

six (6) feet

MAXIMUM SIGN AREA

ten (10) square feet

SIGN TEXT & OTHER REQUIREMENTS

a temporary sign may not display general advertising, may not be illuminated

DAYS AND TIMES SIGNS MAY BE DISPLAYED

A temporary sign may not be displayed on a parcel more than a total of one hundred eighty (180) days in a calendar year.
