

Open House Sign Ordinances – San Mateo County, CA

SIGN LOCATION

On-site

OF SIGNS ALLOWED

The maximum number of signs allowed on a parcel is one (1) sign per parcel, or one (1) sign per each 200 feet of parcel street frontage, or one (1) sign per business, whichever is greatest.

MAXIMUM SIGN HEIGHT

The maximum height of signs on a parcel is as follows: Attached signs shall not exceed the height of the building or structure to which the sign is attached and shall not extend above the roofline. Freestanding signs shall not exceed six (6) feet.

MAXIMUM SIGN AREA

The maximum total display area of all signs on a parcel is three-quarters (0.75) square foot per foot of parcel street frontage

SIGN TEXT & OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The following signs shall be prohibited: Any sign that, because of its location, construction, or operating characteristics, can be confused with a traffic control device or emergency vehicle. Signs having animated, moving, rotating, inflatable, or flashing parts. Signs emitting intense and focused beams of light, including beacons. Off-premises signs. Abandoned signs.
